Over 2.5 million homes and businesses lost power from North Carolina to Connecticut as of Tuesday afternoon, according to [poweroutage.us](http://poweroutage.us). Tropical storm warnings are in effect from the mid-Atlantic to coastal Maine, including New York City and Boston.

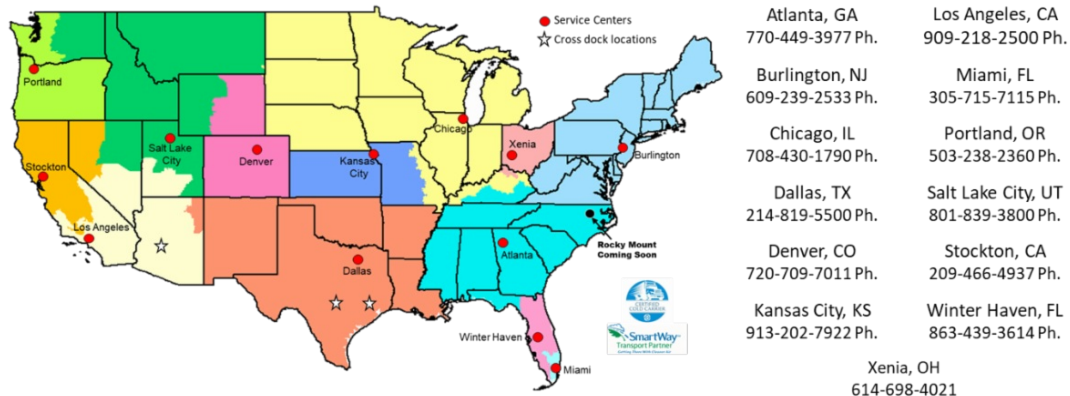


Anticipate delays due to power outages, possible tornadoes, damaging winds, and flooding in affected areas.
